## Wrestling European Olympic Qualifier Tournament 2021 COVID-19 Protocol

### I. Basic concepts

- A. accredited person: participant + staff
- B. participant: team member, referee, VIP, UWW and organizing team (administration, press, healthcare professionals)
- C. team member: competitor, coach, team leader, team doctor, physiotherapist, etc.
- D. crew
  - direct contact: staff actively involved in the care of the participant who come into physical contact with the participant or his / her personal belongings (eg. restaurant service staff, cleaning lady, receptionist, etc.)
  - indirect contact: no physical contact with the participant or his / her personal belongings (eg. security guard, organizing committee, etc.)
- E. Potentially COVID-19 infected person: an asymptomatic person who does not yet have a clear valid PCR test result. **Requires orange zone isolation.**
- F. COVID-19 suspect:
  - a person with suspicious COVID-19 complaints or symptoms until a clear result of the PCR test is available, or
  - a person with 2 positive antigen tests until a clear result of the PCR test
  - a person with a negative antigen test and a positive PCR test until the result of the clear confirmatory PCR test (s)**Requires red zone isolation.**
- G. Suspected complaints / symptoms of COVID-19: fever ( $> 38.0$  C), low fever ( $> 37.4$  C), cough, sore throat, decreased sense of smell and / or taste
- H. Confirmed non-infected person: a person with a valid, clear negative PCR test result.
- I. Person with confirmed COVID-19 infection: asymptomatic or symptomatic person with two positive antigen tests and / or a sufficiently confirmed positive PCR test. **Requires red zone isolation.**

### II. Test station

- A. There is a 24-hour test station at the competition venue, BOK Hall
- B. COVID-19 test waiting area - COVID-19 test room (60 samples per hour at maximum capacity) - negative COVID-19 rapid test waiting room (15 people can stay there at a time, chairs at a distance of 2 m, traffic route marked on the floor) - accreditation
- C. In case of maximum workload (arrival days) 4 tests can be taken in parallel at the same time
- D. COVID-19 station (in the BOK Hall): COVID-19 suspicious symptoms can be indicated here on a form, or a written confirmation of the COVID-19 PCR test result can be requested by presenting the accreditation card

### III. Accreditation process

- A. Upon arrival, everyone must start at the accreditation centre
- B. Do not eat, drink, smoke or chew gum under any circumstances for at least 3 hours prior to arrival for accreditation. It is also forbidden to brush your teeth, rinse your mouth - even with clean water - use candy or any other mouth freshener



- C. Rapid antigen test and PCR test sampling are performed at the test station
- D. Everyone awaits the result of the rapid antigen test (15 minutes) on site
- E. In case of a negative rapid antigen test result, you will receive an accreditation card with which you can only enter the accommodation and the training site (Körcsarnok) (still considered as “potentially COVID-19 infected”)
- F. The result of the PCR test is received within 12 hours
- G. In the event of a negative PCR test result, you will receive a hologram sticker on your accreditation card at the COVID-19 station in the BOK Hall, allowing you to move freely within the bubble, including the BOK Hall and the location of the organized meals (“confirmed non-infected person”).

## IV. COVID-19 testing protocol

The gold standard is the PCR test, as it has the highest specificity and sensitivity (the lowest ratio of false-positive and false-negative test results). A rapid antigen test is only suitable for pre-screening (as its sensitivity is not high enough, so the rate of false-negative results is relatively high) and is especially justified in cases where there are more than one person in a room or if someone is producing symptoms.

Both the rapid antigen test and the PCR test are performed on a sample taken from the nose and throat. A rapid antigen test on site gives results within 15 minutes, and the PCR test is detected within 12 hours of arrival at the laboratory. The results of all tests are recorded in English (also), in the case of PCR on the laboratory report, in the case of a rapid antigen test on the form provided for this purpose.

Everyone will receive written documentation of the results of the rapid test on site, and the results of the PCR test can be requested in form of a printed copy at the on-site COVID-19 station, presenting the accreditation card.

- A. Screening of a participant from abroad
  - 1) Entry into the territory of Hungary (based on Government Decree 408/2020 (VIII.30.)):
    - within 3 days prior to the sporting event, with a negative result to a single PCR test
  - 2) Entering the bubble
    - rapid antigen tests and PCR tests are performed simultaneously at the test station set up at the competition venue
    - everyone awaits the result of their own rapid antigen test on site
    - participants with a negative rapid antigen test result can go for accreditation
    - until the result of the PCR test, athletes can leave their room only for training, they can only enter the Körcsarnok (not BOK Hall), and can only train on the designated training mat with the athletes of their own country
    - in the case of a positive rapid antigen test, the rapid test is repeated immediately
      - if it gives a positive result again, the person must be considered a COVID-19 suspect until at least the result of the PCR test and isolated in a designated hotel room, which he / she cannot leave until at least the result of the PCR test



- if the repeated rapid test gives a negative result, a third rapid test must be performed and then proceed accordingly
  - if both the rapid antigen test and the PCR test are negative, the participant should be considered as a **CONFIRMED NON-INFECTED** and **can move freely within the bubble**
  - if both the rapid antigen test and the PCR test are positive, the participant must be considered **CONFIRMED COVID-19 INFECTED**, isolated in a designated hotel room and **excluded from further participation in the sporting event**
  - if the rapid antigen test is negative and the PCR test is positive, the PCR test must be repeated as soon as possible (but at least 12 hours after the first test) and the person must be treated as a COVID-19 suspect at least until the result of the repeated PCR test and must be isolated in a hotel room designated for this purpose
  - if the rapid antigen test is positive 2 times and then the PCR test is negative, the PCR test must be repeated as soon as possible (but at least 12 hours after the first test) and the person must be treated as a COVID-19 suspect and must be isolated in a hotel room designated for this purpose
  - if the result of the repeated PCR test is the same as the result of the first PCR test, the participant should be treated as CONFIRMED COVID-19-INFECTED or CONFIRMED NON-INFECTED according to this result
  - if the result of the repeated PCR test is inconsistent with the result of the previous PCR test, the PCR test must be repeated a third time as soon as possible and the person must be considered a COVID-19 suspect until at least the result of third PCR test is available and must be isolated in a designated hotel room
  - PCR testing should be continued until 2 consecutive PCR tests give the same test result, and then the last 2 identical test results should be used to treat the person as CONFIRMED COVID-19 INFECTED or CONFIRMED NON-INFECTED.
- 3) PCR testing required for travelling back home: it is possible if the team leader of the given country indicates the need at the accreditation at the latest
- B. Screening of a participant from Hungary: a Hungarian participant or a foreign participant who arrived in the country earlier than 3 days before the start of the competition (eg. from a training camp in Hungary)
- 1) Entering the bubble
- competitors arriving from a Hungarian training camp with a negative PCR test not earlier than 24 hours
  - rapid antigen test sampling is performed at the test station set up at the competition venue before accreditation
  - Everyone awaits the result of their own rapid antigen test on site
  - A participant with a negative rapid antigen test can go for accreditation
  - In the case of a positive rapid antigen test, the rapid test is repeated immediately



- if it gives a positive result again, a PCR test must be taken and the person must be considered a COVID-19 suspect at least until the result of the PCR test and isolated in a designated hotel room
- if the repeated rapid test gives a negative result, a third rapid test must be performed and then proceed accordingly
- if the **rapid antigen test is negative**, the participant should be considered as **CONFIRMED NON-INFECTED** and **can move freely within the bubble**
- if the **rapid antigen test is positive**, the rapid test must be repeated, if the **rapid antigen test is positive on the second time**, a PCR test must be taken, until the result the athlete must be treated as a COVID-19 suspect and must be isolated in a hotel room designated for this purpose
- if both the **rapid antigen test and the PCR test give a positive result**, the participant must be considered **CONFIRMED COVID-19 INFECTED** and **excluded from further participation in the sporting event and must be isolated in a designated hotel room or in case of obtaining a Hungarian residency the athlete must be obliged to stay in quarantine at home**
- if the **rapid antigen test is positive 2 times** and then the **PCR test is negative**, the PCR test must be repeated as soon as possible (but at least 12 hours after the first test) and the person must be treated as a COVID-19 suspect and must be isolated in a hotel room designated for this purpose, which he/she shall not leave until at least the result of the repeated PCR test is available
- if the result of the repeated PCR test is the same as the result of the first PCR test, the participant should be treated as CONFIRMED COVID-19 INFECTED or CONFIRMED NON-INFECTED according to this result
- if the result of the repeated PCR test is inconsistent with the result of the previous PCR test, the PCR test must be repeated a third time as soon as possible and the person must be considered a COVID-19 suspect until at least the third PCR test and must be isolated in a hotel room designated for the case, which he/she cannot leave until at least the result of the third PCR test is available
- PCR testing should be continued until 2 consecutive PCR tests give the same test result, and then the last 2 identical test results should be used to treat the person as CONFIRMED COVID-19 INFECTED or NON-INFECTED.

### C. Staff screening

- direct contact with the participant: can start working with a negative result of a PCR test taken up to 36 hours before the start of work
- indirect contact with the participant: rapid antigen test before the first time getting into work

### D. Testing a COVID-19 suspect based on complaints / symptoms

- in the event of a suspected COVID-19 complaint, the COVID-19 medical coordinator should be notified, a rapid antigen test and PCR test should be performed, and immediate red-zone isolation should be ordered
- the COVID-19 suspect awaits the result of the rapid antigen test on site in isolation from other waiting participants
- a participant with a negative rapid antigen test goes straight to a designated hotel room (red zone isolation) and cannot leave it until at least the result of the PCR test



- in the case of a positive rapid antigen test, the rapid test is repeated immediately
    - if it returns positive, the person should be considered a COVID-19 suspect at least until the result of the PCR test and isolated in a designated hotel room
    - if the repeated rapid test gives a negative result, a third rapid test must be carried out and then proceed accordingly;
  - if both the **rapid antigen test and the PCR test are negative**, the participant should be considered **CONFIRMED NON-INFECTED** and **can move freely within the bubble**
  - if both **the rapid antigen test and the PCR test give a positive result**, the participant must be considered **CONFIRMED COVID-19 INFECTED** and **excluded from further participation in the sporting event and must be isolated in a designated hotel room or in case of obtaining a Hungarian residency the athlete must be obliged to stay in quarantine at home**
  - if the **rapid antigen test is negative** and the **PCR test is positive**, the PCR test must be repeated as soon as possible (but at least 12 hours after the first test) and until the result of the repeated PCR test the person must be treated as a COVID-19 suspect and must be isolated in a hotel room designated for this purpose
  - if the **rapid antigen test is positive 2 times** and then the **PCR test is negative**, the PCR test must be repeated as soon as possible (but at least 12 hours after the first sampling) and the person must be treated as a COVID-19 suspect and must be isolated in a hotel room designated for this purpose
  - if the result of the repeated PCR test is the same as the result of the first PCR test, the participant should be treated as CONFIRMED COVID-19 INFECTED or CONFIRMED NON-INFECTED according to this result
  - if the result of the repeated PCR test is inconsistent with the result of the previous PCR test, the PCR test must be repeated a third time as soon as possible and the person must be considered a COVID-19 suspect until at least the result of third PCR test is available and must be isolated in a hotel room designated for this purpose
  - PCR testing should be continued until 2 consecutive PCR tests give the same test result, and then the last 2 identical test results should be used to treat the person as CONFIRMED COVID-19 INFECTED or NON-INFECTED.
- E. Screening of a person who has been in contact with a confirmed COVID-19 infected person ("contact research")
- From the possible contacts of confirmed COVID-19 infected people, the organizing committee will determine the actual number of contacts and decide on their further participation in the event.

## V. Bubble system

### A. Operation of the bubble system

- the concept of a bubble system: theoretically a closed system where the person entering it does not come into direct contact with a person outside the bubble
- to enter the bubble system and move freely there is only possible by fulfilling the test protocol, and having negative test results



- aim: the tested, non infected person should not come into direct contact with an untested, potentially COVID-19 infected person, but should be able to move freely within it
- participants can only leave the bubble after accreditation in justified cases, with prior permission (eg. use of a higher level of medical care)
- movement of participants: *arrival in the country - transfer from the airport to the test station - entry into the bubble - accommodation - training and competition venue - exit from the bubble - departure from the country*

## B. Basic rules of conduct and mask wearing

- 1) Mask wearing: except when doing sports, eating and staying in your own hotel rooms, it is mandatory for everyone (including staff)!
- 2) Social distancing: important to ensure that the participants keep a distance of 1.5 m from each other (both indoors and outdoors) continuously (except when doing sports), preferably within 2 m of each other indoors, or only for the minimum time required (in any case less than 15 minutes). In situations for longer stays (eg. tables, chairs, waiting points), the staying points must be at least 2 m apart.
- 3) Direct contact (except when doing sports) should be avoided, so it is recommended to avoid handshakes, hugs, kisses
- 4) Increased attention should be paid to basic hygiene rules:
  - regular hand disinfection should be ensured, especially when entering and leaving indoor spaces, before and after meals, before and after using the toilet
  - change the mask frequently, but at least daily
  - toilets and showers are disinfected after each use, be patient until the cleaning staff performs the necessary cleaning
  - (sports) equipment used by several athletes (eg barbell, stretcher) must be cleaned regularly with a surface disinfectant before / after each use
  - everyone should take care of their own fluid replacement, each other's bottles should not be used
- 5) After accreditation, those arriving by their own car can only travel on foot or by official shuttle buses, not by their own car
- 6) All accredited persons are required to report to COVID-19 station or to the e-mail address designated for this purpose if they notice COVID-19 suspicious symptoms in themselves

## C. Locations of the bubble system

- 1) Accommodation
  - Rooms (1 or 2 persons)
- 2) Organized meals:
  - ensure adequate distance between tables and chairs, sit every 1.5 m apart, catering staff must wear masks and rubber gloves
  - Buffet service staff will assist with serving meals
  - shopping - shopping runner, transfer room with hand sanitizer and disinfectant cloth to wipe products
- 3) Training venue (Körcsarnok)
  - dressing: changing boxes separated by country
  - common areas (toilet, shower): disinfectant cleaning after each use by the designated cleaning staff
- 4) Competition venue (BOK Sports Hall)





- registration, equipment inspection, weighting: in mask, distance points
- dressing: changing boxes separated by country, which will be cleaned with a surface disinfectant at least once a day after the departure of the participants
- common areas (toilet): disinfectant cleaning after each use by the designated cleaning staff
- shoe disinfection: when entering the competition venue, entering the warm-up room, stepping on the carpet, especially when stepping on the competition mat, must be passed through a disinfecting doormat
- warm-up mat: hand disinfection before entry
- carpet: hourly disinfectant wash
- medal ceremony: all participants must wear masks, hand disinfection is obligatory for the ones giving out the medals immediately before the ceremony, no contact (handshake, kiss)

## 5) Transfer bus

- sit at every second seat
- hand disinfection at the door
- mandatory mask wearing
- the driver is responsible for venting the bus after each ride
- the driver is responsible for disinfecting the bus after each ride with a surface disinfectant

## D. Monitoring of the bubble system

### 1) Protocol control, compliance - COVID-19 marshal

task: to warn those who may not cooperate with the rules (correct mask wearing, mandatory directions of travel, use of disinfection points)

- 2 persons per hotel: corridor, restaurant
- 2 persons per hall at the training and competition venue
- 1 person on each shuttle bus

### 2) At the time of accreditation, each person must declare in writing:

- knows and accepts the COVID-19 protocol
- notes that COVID-19 has a reporting obligation in case of a suspected symptom
- agrees that the test results will be given to the organizing committee

## E. Infection control

- entry points: hotel, competition venue: separate exit and entrance, thermometer, a separate gate at the competition venue for the athletes, referees and organizers
- hand disinfection points: at entry points, at hotel canteens and common washrooms, possibility to wipe products purchased by shopping runners with disinfectant wipes, at the competition site at the entrance of a test station, in changing rooms and in washrooms
- mask wearing: all the time, except when doing sports, meals and being in your own hotel room, for everyone
- queuing: distance points need to be designated in places where there is a chance to wait (entrance,
- information boards: correct use of masks, correct way to wash hands, do not go to the toilet, shower until the cleaner has disinfected it, keeping distance



## VI. Treatment of suspected COVID-19 cases, and confirmed COVID-19 positive cases

- A. Potential COVID-19 infected person: **orange zone**
- B. COVID-19 suspect: in all cases a rapid antigen test and PCR test is carried out, **red zone** pending final evaluation
- C. **red zone** for an officially confirmed COVID-19 infected person
- D. the fact of the positive test and the details of the person concerned (name, country) are immediately reported by the rapid tester or by the PCR test laboratory to the COVID-19 medical coordinator, who reports to the main organizer of the competition and to the National Public Health Centre (NNK)
- E. Communicating COVID-19 positivity to the data subject: in the possession of a written report, the COVID-19 MEDICAL coordinator or a designated member of the organizing committee jointly (even a UWW physician) communicates the data subject in person
- F. COVID-19 transfer bus: patient dressed (FFP, rubber gloves), driver must wear FFP mask, at least 1.5 meters from the (potentially) infectious person
- G. Isolation:
  - orange zone:
    - the participant's hotel room
    - the person can only exit for training and eating (with separated table) purposes from there until the final test result, no one can enter there until then, except the roommate
    - telephone connection is preferred
  - red zone:
    - there must be a separate room in the designated hotel ("sick room"), there must always be at least 3 empty, prepared rooms in the "COVID-19 hotel"
    - mandatory equipment of the room: telephone, 1 non-contact thermometer, 5 questionnaires in English to assess current complaints, hazardous waste collection bag, information on what to do in English
    - may be entered by: medical staff, designated member of the organizing committee when announcing the result (if necessary), in appropriate protective clothing
    - meals, provision of necessary items: food and drink placed in front of the room door, disposable cutlery and packaging, towels, garbage bags if necessary, etc.: "non-contact" pick-up: the staff knocks and then leaves, the person concerned is obliged for 10 seconds wait until the door opens
    - cleaning: cleaning service is not provided, in case of extreme need a cleaning lady enters in suitable protective clothing
    - All waste generated must be treated as hazardous waste and thus collected
    - Disposal of hazardous waste: the sealed collection bag must be transported every 3 days packed in another hazardous waste bag
    - collection of used textiles: to be collected in double nylon bags, to be transported every 1-3 days as required, to be washed directly in the washing machine at 60 degrees with a disinfectant detergent
